Artists are responsible for shipping and insurance for delivery of their work. We will pay for return. Original artworks will remain on loan through the exhibition until July 29, 2017. The artworks will be returned to the artists within one month of the end of the display.

The invoice submits to customs through the shipper must include

- high resolution digital images of the original artworks in JPG (color RGB) format with at least 350 dpi
- head shot portrait of the artist (300 dpi JPG) with your contact information and a short biographical paragraph (<100 words).
- a brief description of each artwork, including title of artwork, scientific (Latin) name and common name of the subject, completion date, media and size of artwork.
- and a short reflection (<100 words) about the artwork, which will be included in commemorative book. If you have multiple entries, please include all entries into one form.
